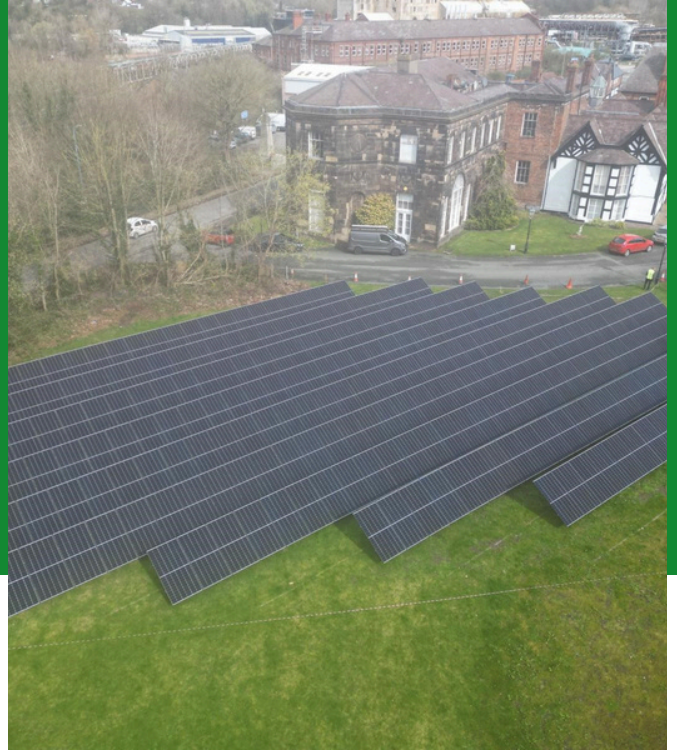


# UKSPF Anderson Bevan

## BACKGROUND

Anderson Bevan, based in Northwich, providing office rental services since 2007 within the Grade 1 listed building at Winnington Hall. The company had previously invested in sustainability measures such as LED lighting and double glazing, with future plans for boiler replacement. Facing increased energy costs post-Covid and due to energy crises, Anderson Bevan were exploring ground-mounted solar panels to mitigate expenses for the 40 businesses housed within the hall.

## WHAT WE DID

Groundwork were the appointed delivery partner for Cheshire West and Chester for this grant programme. We supported Anderson Bevan on their grant application progress by;

- Conducting a site visit to review of all their energy consumption measures
- Calculating their carbon emissions, undertook a cost/benefit analysis
- Developed an action plan and business case for investment
- Supported Anderson Bevan with the grant application process

## OUTCOMES

Following our support, Anderson Bevan was able to install ground mounted Solar Panels on their site, resulting in:

- £31,960 cost savings per year
- 21.21 tonnes of carbon saved per year
