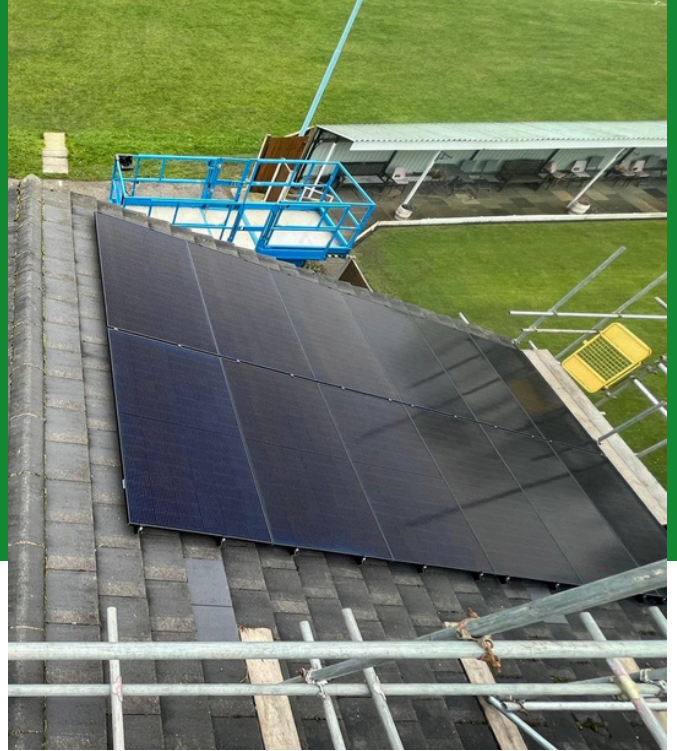

BACKGROUND

Barnton Cricket Club, located in Northwich, offers facilities for cricket, squash, and bowls, as well as social amenities like bars and catering. These spaces are utilised by community groups and for private events. The club comprises two main buildings: the clubhouse, constructed in the 1950s with some 1990s extensions, and a squash court facility built in the 1980s. The club has taken steps towards sustainability by installing electric underfloor heating and is interested in further cost-cutting and carbon emission reduction measures.

WHAT WE DID

Groundwork were the appointed delivery partner for Cheshire West and Chester for this grant programme. We supported Barnton Cricket on their grant application progress by;

- Conducting a review of solar panel technology to be installed in their site
- Calculating their carbon emissions, undertook a cost/benefit analysis
- Developed an action plan and business case for investment
- Supported Barnton Cricket with the grant application process

OUTCOMES

Following our support, Barnton Cricket was able to install Solar PV Panels to the roof of their site, resulting in:

- £4,749 cost savings per year
- 5.05 tonnes of carbon saved per year
- Further savings of £200 per year identified through energy monitoring using Smart Meters
