BACKGROUND

Farrall's Group is a family run business established in 1956 located just outside of Chester which provides distribution and warehousing solutions. Their fleet currently stands at 80 vehicles and operates from 3 warehouses, all of which hold the British Retail Consortium's AA Certification.

Farrall's Group are keen to reduce their carbon emissions and support the local community, who have an ambition to become England's first carbon neutral village.

WHAT WE DID

Groundwork were the appointed delivery partner for Cheshire West and Chester for this grant programme. We supported Farrall's Group on their grant application progress by;

- Conducting a review of solar panel technology installation to support their energy reduction
- Calculating their carbon emissions, undertook a cost/benefit analysis
- Developed an action plan and business case for investment
- Supported Farrall's Group with the grant application process

OUTCOMES

Following our support, Farrall's Group was able to install Solar PV panels to the roof of their site, resulting in:

- £5,752 cost savings per year
- 7.76 tonnes of carbon saved per year
