BACKGROUND

Woodhouse Plumbing, Heating & Electrical Ltd was established in 2007 in Cheshire. The company prioritises reliability, friendly service, and community support, fostering trust among local businesses and residents. Their services include solar, EV, renewable energy, underfloor heating, and bathroom installations, aligning with their commitment to sustainability. In 2021, they purchased office premises in Frodsham and installed Solar PV Panels on site to contribute to the national effort to achieve Net Zero by 2025.

WHAT WE DID

Groundwork were the appointed delivery partner for Cheshire West and Chester for this grant programme. We supported Woodhouse on their grant application progress by;

- Conducting a review of supporting their business in energy reduction through various low and zero carbon technology measures
- Calculating their carbon emissions, undertook a cost/benefit analysis
- Developed an action plan and business case for investment
- Supported Woodhouse with the grant application process

OUTCOMES

Following our support, Woodhouse was able to install an Air Source Heat Pump, Underfloor Heating and Solar energy storage unit on-site, resulting in:

- £7,029 cost savings per year
- 14.26 tonnes of carbon saved per year
