UKSPF Lady Heyes Holiday Park







BACKGROUND

Lady Heyes is a privately owned holiday park offering Glamping pod and pitches for touring caravans, motorhomes and tents. The park is open all year round and hosts a range of facilities including leisure and retail units. Covering 14 acres, the site has evolved from a mid-20th Century agricultural business to a modern holiday park, hosting a variety of independent businesses including a vehicle garage, antiques centre, furniture shops, beauty treatments and general retail units. All units onsite comprise of modern energy efficiency components such as double glazing, underfloor heating and insulation.

WHAT WE DID

Groundwork was appointed as the delivery partner for Cheshire West and Chester's UKSPF grant programme. We assisted Lady Heyes Holiday Park with their grant application process by:

- Conducting an on-site visit to assess building plans and energy consumption
- · Calculated their carbon impact from their large electricity and gas usage
- · Presented the business with an action plan and business case for solar PV investment
- Providing support throughout the grant application process

OUTCOMES

With our support, Lady Heyes Holiday Park successfully installed an impressive 350 kWp solar PV system leading to:

- £67,345 in annual cost savings
- 70.5 tonnes of CO2e reduced per year
- Identified additional opportunities surrounding a full lighting replacement towards energy-efficient LEDs and voltage optimisation.
